18 out of 33 seats in the Tennessee State Senate are up for grabs. So are ALL 99 seats in House of Representatives.

WHAT are your thoughts on low-wage jobs in rural TN areas?

We lost NINE hospital in TN because our leaders chose not to expand medicaid. Over 33% of workers in rural areas make less that \$7/hr and are 3x more likely to be uninsured.

NO insurance. NO hospitals. NO affordable housing. WHAT company is going to move there and offer jobs?

Join others across the state who are working for a greater economic justice in the face of growing income gaps and poverty in TN.
